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




**Personal Security Index (PSI): W**orry about losing job, Worry about not being able to give children a good education

<u>Neighbourhood Security Index (NSI)</u>: Drug sale in the streets, Robberies, Alcohol consumption in the streets

**Exterior Security Index (ESI):** Worry about international war, Worry about terrorist attack, Worry about civil war.

**Total Security Index (TSI):** Sum of Indexes of Personal (PSI), Neighbourhood (NSI) and Exterior (ESI) Security.
